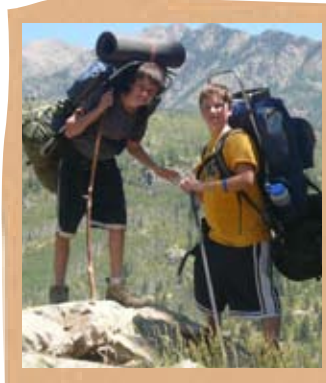

For 9 days, Trailblazers will explore the deserts, mountains and rivers of Colorado. This trip will emphasize camping skills, outdoor education, team building, personal and leadership development and lots of fun. Located in southwest Colorado, Colvig Silver Camps is a private 600 acre residential camp that is ACA accredited and has been
